



PROCESSOR ID APPLICATION

An NCPDP Processor ID (BIN) is assigned only in the event of ANSI IIN Number application denial. It is recommended that an ANSI IIN Number be used for all EDI transactions. For information on obtaining an ANSI IIN Number, contact Jessica Carl at (212) 642-4903 at ANSI Headquarters in New York, NY. The ANSI IIN form is also available on the ANSI web site at www.ansi.org (under "Identifier Registration").

NCPDP assumes no liability for the NCPDP Processor ID (BIN). It is important to realize that the NCPDP Processor ID assigned may at some point collide with an ANSI IIN Number assigned. At that point, the ANSI IIN Number has precedence.

The cost to obtain an NCPDP Processor ID is \$375. Please note there is a five (5) business-day processing cycle.
