



New Universal Claim Form Required for Use March 1, 2013

Due to changes required for Medicare Part D processing of claims with dates of service on or after February 28, 2013, a new version of the NCPDP Telecommunication vD.0 Continuous Feed (PUCF-D02PT) and Laser Universal Claim Form (PUCF-D01PT) have been created. Medicare Part D sponsors will be required to submit additional fields to CMS based on the CMS notice dated October 1, 2012 referencing *Revised Reporting Requirements for Prescriber Identifiers and Other Prescription Drug Event Fields*. Pharmacies currently submit these fields on real-time claims and the UCFs have been updated to accommodate.

To accommodate the reporting requirement **version 1.2** of the NCPDP Telecommunication vD.0 Continuous Feed (PUCF-D02PT) and Laser Universal Claim Form (PUCF-D01PT) contains the following modifications from version 1.1:

- Designation of "Version 1.2 – 02/2013" in top right box.
- Pharmacy Service Type (147-U7) has been added.
- Patient Residence Code (384-4X) has been added.
- Submission Clarification Code (420-DK) box allows for the submission of three values.
- Quantity Prescribed (460-ET) has been added.
- Fields ID have been renumbered to accommodate the additions.

In addition, the following fields have been added to support Long Term Care appropriate dispensing (short cycle):

- Special Packaging Indicator (429-DT)
- CMS Part D Qualified Facility (997-G2)

A sample of the NCPDP Telecommunication vD.0 Continuous Feed (PUCF-D02PT) and Laser Universal Claim Form (PUCF-D01PT) will be available **for programming purposes** only in late December 2012. When published, the *Manual Claim Forms Reference Implementation Guide v1.2 December 2012* reflects these updates.

The NCPDP Telecommunication vD.0 Continuous Feed (PUCF-D02PT) and Laser Universal Claim Form (PUCF-D01PT) will be available for ordering on February 1, 2013 and will be required for use effective March 1, 2013 for Medicare Part D claims. Version 1.1 of the Universal Claim Form will be sunsetted as the supply dwindles.
