Waiver of Liability Related to COVID-19

Even with precautionary measures taken by NCPDP, attendees and staff, it is not possible to completely prevent the presence of the disease and NCPDP cannot guarantee you will not become exposed to or contract COVID-19 while participating in the NCPDP 2022 Annual Technology & Business Conference.
