In response to the Office of Inspector General (OIG), Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) Final Rule, Fraud and Abuse; Removal of Safe Harbor Protection for Rebates Involving Prescription Pharmaceuticals and Creation of New Safe Harbor Protection for Certain Point-of-Sale Reductions in Price on Prescription Pharmaceuticals and Certain Pharmacy Benefit Manager Service Fees, The WG1 Point of Sale Rebate Review Task Group reviewed the final rule specifically as it relates to new safe harbor for price reductions on prescription pharmaceutical products that meet certain criteria. This DERF intends to provide a mechanism for the payer/PBM to optionally communicate either the amount of the Point-of-Sale Rebate/Chargeback, the patient savings due to the POS Rebate/Chargeback, or both in the claim response in non-pricing formula fields.

The DERF proposes to add two new Additional Message Information Qualifiers (132-UH) in which the amounts mentioned above can be returned in a claim response.

For new temporary pharmacies:

- Obtain an NPI at the [National Plan and Provider Enumeration System \(NPPES\)](#) and provide NCPDP a copy of the confirmation email you receive. If you are unable to access the Internet, NCPDP will do this for you.
- Provide NCPDP with your Legal Business Name, physical address, telephone, Relationship ID (affiliation code), Tax ID (EIN), pharmacy class (chain, independent, government, other), open date, and your contact name, email address, phone and extension.

For pharmacies evacuated or temporarily closed:

- Provide your pharmacy NCPDP (NABP) ID, Name, Relationship ID (affiliation code if assigned), status (inactive), date of status, physical address, contact name and phone, contact email. You may update your status with NCPDP at any time 7:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. PDT.

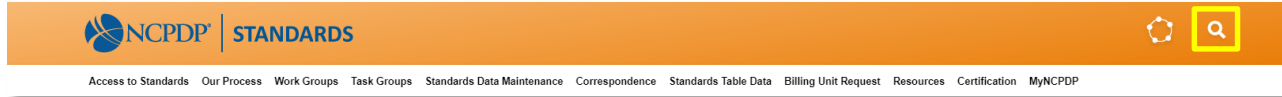
